## Trinity Sunday – June 22 What is a Eucharistic Procession?

The procession is a way of publicly showing faith and adoration for the Eucharist, believing it is truly the body and blood of Christ. The practice dates back to the 14th century and has been promoted by popes and saints. The procession often takes place after a Mass on the Feast of Corpus Christi. The Blessed Sacrament is placed in a monstrance and carried out of the church and into the streets, usually while singing and praying. The procession is a way to make the Eucharist known to the broader community and to remind Catholics of their faith and commitment to following Christ.



#### **Our Eucharistic Procession**


